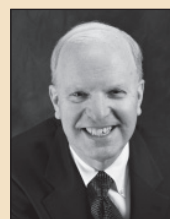

## Happy Birthday, Ladies' Fellowship!

### A 100 Year Legacy of Hospitality

Our 2011 camp meeting marks the centennial of the Indian Springs Ladies' Fellowship. Founded in 1911 as a hospitality ministry, the 'Women's Auxiliary' provided chimney lamps, pitchers and maid service to the evangelists and other workers.

Over time, the Women's Auxiliary expanded to provide general grounds beautification, furnishings for the Workers' Cottages and support for our missionary families. The organization is now called the Ladies' Fellowship.

The breadth of ministry includes the sponsorship of the Legacy Ladies Project which honors women who have made a difference at Indian Springs. The founding purpose of hospitality remains, as demonstrated by the 2011 ministry of 'adopting' our Workers' Cottages. Members host a cottage, ensuring the comfort of workers and families during camp.

To celebrate this memorable milestone of 100 years, the first Ladies' Spring Retreat was held in April 2011 on the camp ground. Led by our own Beth Coppedge from The Titus Women, 75 women enjoyed Bible study, special music and inspired fellowship.

## Tribute to Karen & Tommy Padgett

### Heartfelt Thanks for 30 Years of Youth Ministry

The first time Tommy Padgett brought his youth group to Indian Springs in 1980, he never dreamed that Coach Cecil Zwifel would ask him and his wife, Karen, to lead the youth program! At that time, Tommy was a youth pastor at Avalon United Methodist Church in Albany, Georgia. He and Karen had attended Indian Springs since the late 1960's through the invitation of Hoyd and Mary Ellen Davis.

Tommy and Karen started their work and found that the youth program needed an overhaul. The Padgettts were faced with the constant challenge of finding speakers and youth counselors; a recreation program needed to be developed resulting in the successful Ropes Course. Despite all the obstacles they encountered, the Padgettts transformed the Youth Ministry.

When asked what he found rewarding by being involved in the Youth Ministry, Tommy said, “We realized we were a small part of what God wanted to accomplish in the lives of the Youth at Indian Springs. Our responsibility was to facilitate God's plan.”

Despite the challenges of balancing their family life at camp meeting with their ministry commitment, Karen faithfully assisted Tommy and other Youth workers. The Padgettts are deeply grateful that Indian Springs has made a significant impact in the lives of their two children, Andrew and Trelle.
