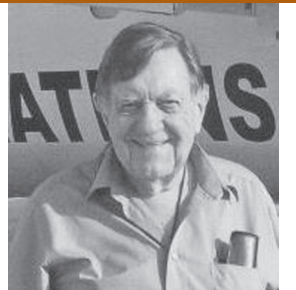

## Meet Charles Drake... A Man for Missions



Charles Drake's ministry sprang from roots grown at Indian Springs. His father was a Methodist minister in the North Georgia Conference and brought this family to campmeeting.

At the altar in the Main Tabernacle with Dr. J. C. McPheeters' guidance and prayer, Charles gave his heart and life to God. Since then he and his wife, Dot, have missed only a very few camp meetings.

Over the past 30 years, his heart's cry has been for missions. He became involved with Haitian missions through Pastor Nicolas Juste. Pastor Juste has planted almost 30 churches, schools and orphanages in Haiti. Many of these churches were destroyed by the earthquake earlier this year.

As a retired building contractor, construction and sharing Jesus Christ are his mission goals. Mission opportunities have opened in numerous countries, including Panama, Kenya, Liberia, Iraq, and Haiti.

Most recently, Charles accompanied the medical team from Conscience International to Haiti. The devastation was overwhelming, but the team provided both physical and spiritual needs for the people of Haiti.
